

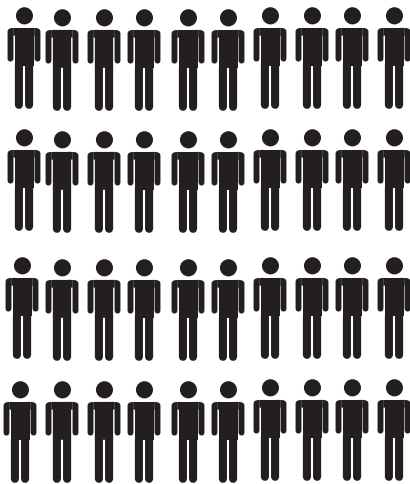

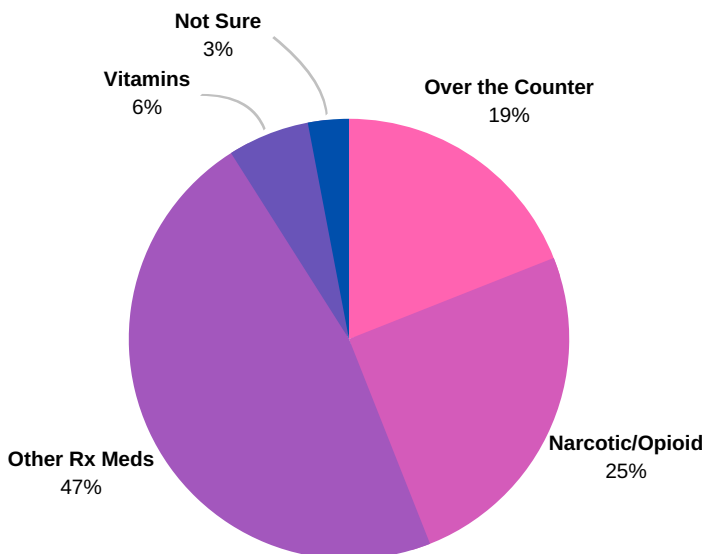
39,000+ POUCHES DISTRIBUTED*



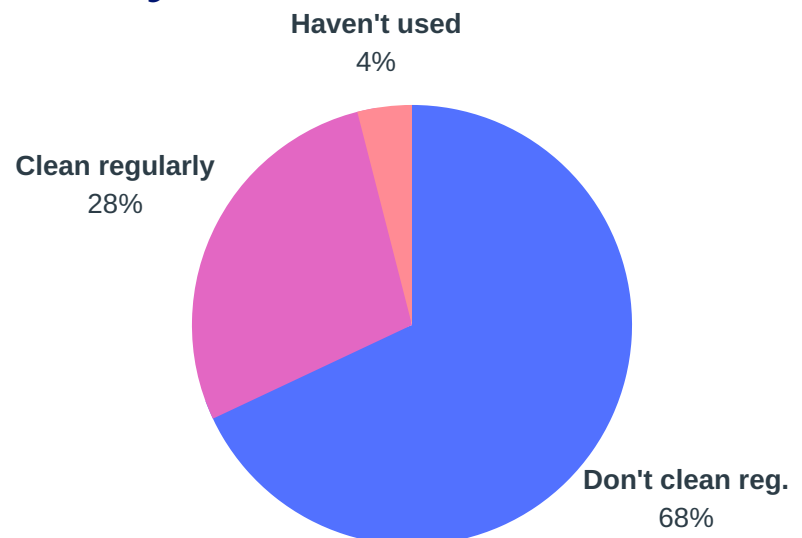
*If used to capacity, these 39,000 pouches will have safely eliminated 1.3 million pills and an estimated 325,000 opiates, according to survey data

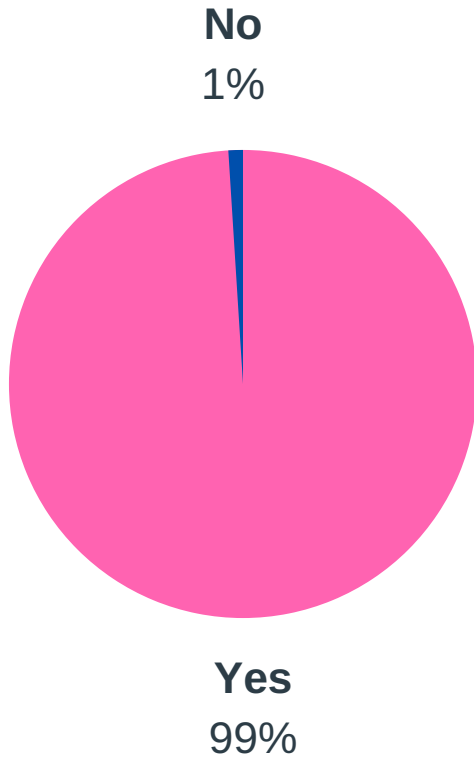
What types of medicine did you dispose of?*

Was the pouch easy to use? **

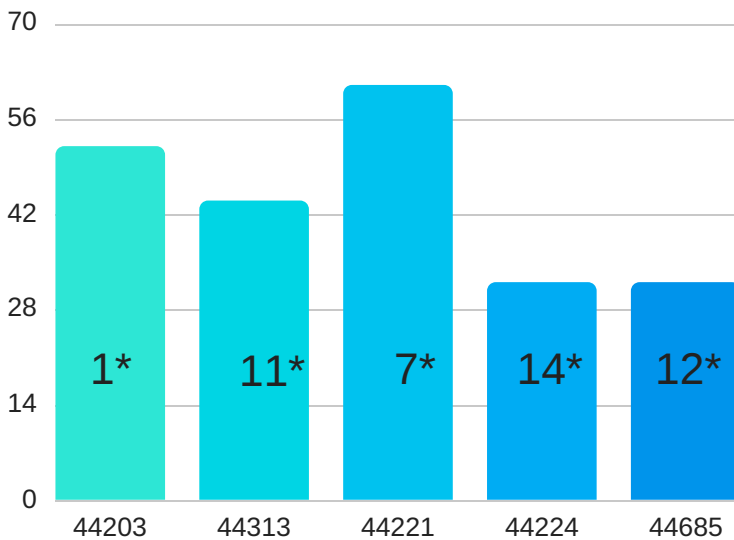
